Dear Mr. Matheson,

The City Election's Officer has reviewed the prospective recall petition forms (SEL 350 and SEL 351) submitted on Friday, July 1, 2016, along with the amended forms submitted on Tuesday, July 5, 2016. The prospective recall petition forms meet the requirements. The petition is approved and ready to circulate. The City has assigned Petition No. 2016-01 to this prospective recall petition.

Pursuant to my communication with Clackamas County Elections Division on July 1, 2016, the total number of Oregon City votes cast for Governor during the November 4, 2014 election was 12,189 and 15% of that is 1,828. Therefore, **1,828** valid signatures in Oregon City would be required to place the measure on the ballot.

The Recall Manual published by the Secretary of State Elections Division instructs petition circulators of the circulation requirements. ORS 249.875(1) states the gathering of signatures on a petition to recall a public officer may not exceed a period of 90 days from the date the petition is submitted to the filing officer. **Signatures are due to the City Election's Officer no later than 5 p.m. on Monday, October 3, 2016.**
