SUMMARY

Requires prospective contractors to list in bid or proposal submitted in response to solicitation for public contract five individuals or entities to which prospective contractor contributed most money in connection with ballot measure or election to public office.

Becomes operative January 1, 2018.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to an identification of political contributions in responses to solici-
3 itations for public contracts; and declaring an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part**
6 **of ORS chapter 279A.**

7 **SECTION 2. (1) Every prospective contractor that submits a bid or**
8 **proposal in response to a solicitation for a public contract shall list in**
9 **the bid or proposal the names, addresses and other contact informa-**
10 **tion for the five individuals or entities to which the prospective con-**
11 **tractor has contributed the most money in connection with a ballot**
12 **measure or election to a public office. The list must include the**
13 **amount of money that the prospective contractor has contributed to**
14 **each individual or entity.**

15 **(2) The Attorney General shall adopt model rules to implement this**
16 **section.**

17 **SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2017 Act applies to a public contract**
18 **that a contracting agency advertises or otherwise solicits or, if the**

1 **contracting agency does not advertise or solicit the public contract,**
2 **to a public contract into which the contracting agency enters on or**
3 **after the operative date specified in section 4 of this 2017 Act.**

4 **SECTION 4. (1) Section 2 of this 2017 Act becomes operative Janu-**
5 **ary 1, 2018.**

6 **(2) The Attorney General and a contracting agency that adopts**
7 **rules under ORS 279A.065 may adopt rules and take any other action**
8 **before the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section that**
9 **is necessary to enable the contracting agency, on and after the oper-**
10 **ative date specified in subsection (1) of this section, to exercise all of**
11 **the duties, functions and powers conferred on the Attorney General**
12 **or the contracting agency by section 2 of this 2017 Act.**

13 **SECTION 5. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate pres-**
14 **ervation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is de-**
15 **clared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect on its passage.**

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
